

ORDINANCE NUMBER 2015-1665

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING ORDINANCE NUMBER 2014-1641, AN ORDINANCE WHICH ADOPTED THE FY 2015 CITY OF MURRAY, KENTUCKY ANNUAL BUDGET BY RESTATING CERTAIN REVENUES AND EXPENDITURES FOR THE CITY OF MURRAY OPERATIONS BUDGET.

WHEREAS, WHEREAS, the City was approved to administer CDBG grant funds on behalf of iwis corporation for the purchase of manufacturing equipment and amended the General Fund Revenues, Special Funded Sources in the amount of \$1,000,000; and

WHEREAS, the City was granted an additional \$300,000 on behalf of iwis corporation and was approved to administer the additional funds for manufacturing equipment.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT HEREBY ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL FOR THE CITY OF MURRAY, KENTUCKY AS FOLLOWS:
