

The City of Murray offers this Wayfinding Signage Program for sealed bids labeled "City of Murray-Wayfinding Signage Program Bid". Bids will be received by Marisa Stewart, Project Manager, 500 Main Street, Murray, KY 42071 until 2:00pm, CST, on Friday, August 28, 2020, at which time all bids will be publicly opened and read aloud in City Hall Council Chambers, 500 Main Street, Murray, KY 42071. Description of the Project: The Wayfinding Signage Program includes fabricating and installing signs beginning at the Murray city limits and expanding throughout the community.

All Bidders must comply with the following:

1. All contractors and DBE subcontractors must be pre-qualified with the Kentucky Transportation Cabinet and possess a Certificate of Eligibility at the time of the bid opening. All other subcontractors must be prequalified when accepting subcontracts.
2. Due to the Federal Funding Source, this project is subject to the Federal Davis-Bacon Act wage rate requirements and Buy America restrictions.
3. Bids shall include a Bid Bond, payable to LPA, in amount not less than 5% of bid.
4. The bidder shall certify that it has secured participation by Disadvantaged Business Enterprises ("DBE") in the amount of three (3%) percent of the total value of this contract and that the DBE participation is in compliance with the requirements of 49 CFR 26 and the policies of the Kentucky Transportation Cabinet pertaining to the DBE Program.
5. A Pre-Bid meeting will be held on Wednesday, August 12, 2020 at 10:00a, CST, in City Hall Conference Room at 500 Main Street, Murray, KY 42071. All interested bidding contractors are strongly encouraged to attend. At the pre-bid meeting specific expectations, procedures, schedules and requirements may be discussed.
6. A unit price bid totaling a lump sum is desired for General Construction. Copies of the Bidding Documents may be purchased at a cost of \$50 (non-refundable) at

7. All work must comply with the LPA Guide, Federal Highway Rules, guidelines, local, state and federal laws.
8. All bids must be made on the required Bid Form and shall not be altered in any way. **The complete bid document must be returned**, not just the bid pages. Failure to return all pages may result in a bid not being eligible for award.
