

MINUTES OF MURRAY HUMAN RIGHTS COMMISSION
December 8, 2014
6:30 P.M.

The Murray Human Rights Commission met in regular session on Monday, December 8, 2014, at 6:30 p.m. in City Hall's Council Chambers of City Hall with Chairperson Jody Cofer Randall presiding.

Chair Cofer Randall welcomed members and called the meeting to order at 6:30 p.m.

Old business:

Chair Cofer Randall stated the Human Rights Ordinance was a standing item and no new action was proposed by the Commission regarding the ordinance.

New business:

Chair Cofer Randall stated the MLK Community Breakfast was scheduled for January 19, 2015, had been sponsored by the City/Commission in the past, and had been discussed electronically by Commissioners. Chair Cofer Randall entertained a motion to submit to administration a recommendation to continue Commission sponsorship of the MLK Community Breakfast at \$150.
