



Murray, KY, July 1, 2009 – A thunderstorm went through the City last night and downed several trees. In order to ensure that all City streets are passable, a crew is removing any tree debris that might be on the streets. The City of Murray will only be clearing the streets of limbs. We will not be picking limbs up from residents. Residents who have tree debris will need to contact the Sanitation Department at 762-0380 and request a special pick-up in order to have it removed. The charge for the special pick-up will be applied to your utility bill. Residents may also contact an independent contractor to have any limbs removed.

Please be advised that limbs have to be less than six (6) feet in length and less than six (6) inches in diameter.
