

Murray Code Enforcement Board Minutes
April 1, 2008

The Murray Code Enforcement Board met in regular session on April 1, 2008 at 5:00 p.m. in the council chambers of City Hall located at 104 North 5th Street.

Board Members Present: Matt Jennings, Thomas Rottinghaus and Sam Underwood

Board Members Absent: Mitzi Key

Others Present: David Roberts, Dannetta Cossey, and Officer Brandon Stice

Chairman Thomas Rottinghaus called the meeting to order and had an attendance roll call.

Approve Minutes from December 4, 2007 Meeting: Chairman Rottinghaus asked for approval of the December 4, 2007 minutes. **Sam Underwood made a motion to approve the December 4, 2007 minutes. Matt Jennings seconded the motion and it carried by a 3-0 voice vote.**

Default Case – Douglas K. Story, Jr.: Chairman Rottinghaus called the default case to order and Dannetta Cossey read the case information. Chairman Rottinghaus asked if any board member had any direct or indirect financial or personal interest in any matter to be decided by the Board. All Board members said no. At this time, Officer Brandon Stice came forward and was sworn in. Officer Brandon Stice stated that on March 8, 2008 he responded to 411 Murray Place and upon his arrival there was extremely loud music that could be heard at the bottom of the stairway and looked to be between thirty to forty people inside and at this time, he issued the citation. Officer Stice said that Officer Weatherford had been there earlier that evening and issued a warning. Chairman Rottinghaus closed the default case and the Board deliberated. **Sam Underwood made a motion that the Respondent, Douglas K. Story, Jr. pay a civil fine in the amount of \$100.00 to the City of Murray within fifteen (15) days from the date of this order. Thomas Rottinghaus seconded the motion and it carried by a 3-0 roll call vote.**

Being no further business, Thomas Rottinghaus made a motion to adjourn.
