

Murray Code Enforcement Board Minutes
August 4, 2009

The Murray Code Enforcement Board met in regular session on August 4, 2009 at 5:00 p.m. in the council chambers of City Hall located at 104 North 5th Street.

Board Members Present: Sam Underwood, Danny Brittain and Thomas Rottinghaus

Board Members Absent: Mitzi Key, and Matt Jennings

Others Present: Jennifer Tolley, Officer Scott Svebakken and general audience.

Chairman Thomas Rottinghaus called the meeting to order and an attendance roll call was then taken.

Approve Minutes from July 7, 2009 Meeting: Chairman Rottinghaus asked for approval of the July 7, 2009 minutes **Thomas Rottinghaus made a motion to approve the July 7, 2009 minutes. Sam Underwood seconded the motion and it carried by a 3-0 voice vote.**

Chairman Rottinghaus introduced the Board members and informed the Respondents of their rights of appeal.

Default Case/Fine Hearing – Wesley Pitts: Chairman Rottinghaus called the default case to order and Jennifer Tolley read the case information. Chairman Rottinghaus asked if any board member had any direct or indirect financial or personal interest in any matter to be decided by the Board. All Board members answered no. Officer Scott Svebakken came forward and was sworn in. Officer Svebakken stated they received a noise complaint for 802 Murray Place. Officer Svebakken said he advised the respondent to keep the noise level down and gave them a warning. Officer Svebakken stated they received another noise complaint for 802 Murray Place and issued Mr. Wesley Pitts a citation. Chairman Rottinghaus said for the record that the Respondent was not present. The board then deliberated. **Chairman Rottinghaus made a motion that the Respondent, Wesley Pitts, did commit a violation as charged in the citation and further order that Respondent, Wesley Pitts pay a fine in the amount of \$100 within seven days from the date of this order to the City Clerk’s Office located at 104 North 5th Street. Danny Brittain seconded the motion and it carried by a 3-0 roll call vote.**

Chairman Rottinghaus read a letter from Fire Marshall Dickie Walls, dated August 4, 2009 stating that the structure located at 1626 Hamilton Avenue was brought into compliance and all violations were corrected.

Being no further business, Thomas Rottinghaus made a motion to adjourn.
