

**Murray Code Enforcement Board Minutes  
December 1, 2009**

The Murray Code Enforcement Board met in regular session on December 1, 2009 at 5:00 p.m. in the council chambers of City Hall located at 104 North 5<sup>th</sup> Street.

**Board Members Present:** Sam Underwood, Danny Brittain, Mitzi Key, and Thomas Rottinghaus

**Others Present:** David Roberts, Jennifer Tolley, and general audience.

Chairman Thomas Rottinghaus called the meeting to order and an attendance roll call was then taken.

**Approve Minutes from September 1, 2009 Meeting:** Chairman Rottinghaus asked for approval of the September 1, 2009 minutes. **Sam Underwood made a motion to approve the September 1, 2009 minutes. Mitzi Key seconded the motion and it carried by a 3-0 voice vote.**

Chairman Rottinghaus introduced the Board members and informed the Respondents of their rights of appeal.

At this time Code Enforcement Board member Danny Brittain entered the room.

**Public Hearing – Jillaili Elmachatt:** Chairman Rottinghaus called the public hearing to order and Jennifer Tolley read the case information. Chairman Rottinghaus asked if any board member had any direct or indirect financial or personal interest in any matter to be decided by the Board. All Board members answered no. Chairman Rottinghaus asked if the Officer was in attendance. David Roberts replied he had been contacted but was not present. At this time Chairman Rottinghaus called forward Jillali Elmachatt. Mr. Elmachatt stated that he was not there when the Officer came out the first time, and no one told him an officer had been out. Mr. Elmachatt went on to say that the officer arrived the second time and issued him a citation. Chairman Rottinghaus closed the public hearing and the board deliberated. **Chairman Rottinghaus made a motion that the case be dismissed and no fine be issued due to absence of the Officer. Danny Brittain seconded the motion and it carried by a 4-0 roll call vote.**

Chairman Rottinghaus notified the Board that Case#09-CEB-0009 Countrywide Financial, paid their fine of \$2,500 on October 13, 2009.

Being no further business, Thomas Rottinghaus made a motion to adjourn.
