Murray Code Enforcement Board Minutes January 7, 2014

The Murray Code Enforcement Board met in regular session on January 7, 2014 at 5:00 p.m. in the council chambers of City Hall located at 104 North 5th Street.

Board Members Present: Chairman Thomas Rottinghaus, Mitzi Key, Danny Brittain and Sam Underwood.

Others Present: Jennifer Tolley, David Roberts, Officer Fortner, Kevin Irwin and general audience.

Chairman Thomas Rottinghaus called the meeting to order and an attendance roll call was then taken.

<u>Approval of January 7, 2014 Minutes</u>: Motion made by Mitzi Key to approve and seconded by Sam Underwood.
