

MINUTES OF THE COUNCIL

April 27, 2023

6:30 P.M.

The Murray City Council met in regular session on Thursday, April 27, 2023, at 6:30 p.m. in the Council Chambers at City Hall with Mayor Bob Rogers presiding.

Mayor Bob Rogers called the meeting to order and welcomed Council members, staff, and guests.

After a moment of reflection, Dr. Strieter led the pledge.


