## MINUTES OF COUNCIL

October 8, 2015 6:30 P.M.

The Murray City Council met in regular session Thursday, October 8, 2015 at 6:30 p.m. in the Council Chambers of City Hall with Mayor Jack Rose presiding.

After a moment of silence, Mr. Bohannon led the Pledge of Allegiance to the Flag.

Mayor Rose welcomed Council members and guests and called the meeting to order.

The minutes of the Council Meeting of September 24, 2015 were presented for approval. Mr. Scott moved; seconded by Ms. Shoemaker. All members voted aye.

Mr. Bohannon moved to open the public hearing for the purpose of obtaining written or oral comments regarding the proposed tax rate for 2015; seconded by Mr. Billington. All members voted aye. There were no comments offered by the public. Dr. Miller moved to close the public hearing; seconded by Ms. Shoemaker. All members voted aye.

Ordinance Number 2015-1677, an ordinance levying an ad valorem tax in the City of Murray, Kentucky for the year 2015 upon all property in the City of Murray as shown by the Calloway County Assessment as of January 1, 2015 was presented for approval on first reading. Mr. Hudspeth moved; seconded by Mr. Billington.

Mayor Rose stated the City was using the same rate as the previous year which, due to growth, would generate an approximate 2% increase in tax revenues.

- a. 16<sup>th</sup> Street Pedestrian Project—Tim Choate from BFW presented a status update on the 16<sup>th</sup> Street engineering design project.
- b. Online tax payments—Chaz Robinson presented a PowerPoint slideshow describing the online program for tax and utility payments.

Mr. Taylor left Council Chambers.

Mayor Rose stated there had been no requests for public comment.

Public Works Committee Chair, Butch Seargent, stated the Public Works Committee met prior to the Council meeting to discuss proposed amendments to the City of Murray's Code of Ordinances Chapter 151: Electrical Code to clearly identify the inspection fee for residential and commercial electrical inspections.

Ordinance Number 2015-1679, an ordinance amending Chapter 151: Electrical Code, specifically Chapter §151.08 to clearly identify the inspection fees for residential and commercial electrical inspections was presented for approval on first reading. Mr. Seargent moved; seconded by Mr. Bohannon.

Mr. Crawford said the proposed changes were necessary to align the FY 2015 budget with the year's actual revenues and expenditures.

Ordinance Number 2015-1682, an ordinance amending Ordinance 2014-1641 an ordinance which adopted the FY 2015 City of Murray, Kentucky annual budget by restating certain revenues and expenditures for the City of Murray was presented for approval on first reading.
