

MINUTES OF COUNCIL

April 14, 2016

6:30 P.M.

The Murray City Council met in regular session Thursday, April 14, 2016, at 6:30 p.m. in the Council Chambers of City Hall with Mayor Jack Rose presiding.

After a moment of silence, Mr. Bell led the Pledge of Allegiance to the Flag.

Mayor Rose welcomed Council members and guests and called the meeting to order.

The minutes of the Council Meeting of March 24, 2016, were presented for approval. **Dr. Miller moved; seconded by Mr. Bohannon.** All members voted aye.

Mayor Rose stated he had no report to present:

Mayor Rose stated there had been no requests for public comment.

Mayor Rose recognized the Murray High School Girls and Boys Basketball Teams for their achievements. He presented certificates. Coach Turner and Coach Flener addressed Council briefly.

Public Works Committee Acting Chair, Dan Miller, stated the Public Works Committee met prior to the Council meeting to discuss three bids:

1. KMAIN 16A multiple intersection ADA compliance—Youngblood Excavating submitted the low bid of \$54,950 for 24 intersection crosswalks (ADA compliance).
2. 1414 – 1415 Vine Street right-of-way drainage improvements—LMD Construction submitted the low bid of \$12,970 for the project.
3. Gas Project bid results—Revell Construction submitted the low bid of \$131,101.80 for 2016 Natural Gas Line Extension on Highway 1497 (Old Murray Paris Road).

Dr. Miller said the Public Works Committee unanimously accepted the three low bids presented and **moved** for Council approval; **Mr. Bohannon seconded.** All members voted aye

Personnel and Finance Committee Chair, Danny Hudspeth, stated the Personnel and Finance Committee met prior to the Council meeting for a FY 2017 Budget overview presentation by Finance Director Luke Crawford. Mr. Hudspeth said the Committee took no action and invited Council members to the Personnel and Finance Committee Budget Meeting scheduled for Tuesday, April 19, 2016, at 6:30 p.m. in Council Chambers of City Hall.

Ordinance Number 2016-1695, an ordinance amending Chapter 96: TAXATION, to create a new section entitled §96.05 “Tax Moratoriums for the Historic Overlay District” which establishes property assessment and reassessment moratoriums for the Historic Overlay District in the City of Murray was presented for approval on second reading. **Mr. Bell moved; seconded by Mr. Bohannon.**

Ordinance Number 2016-1696, an ordinance amending Ordinance 794 of the City of Murray Code of Ordinances so as to rezone property located at 1806 North 4th Street (including the portion of right-of-way to the center line of North 4th Street) from R-2 (Residential) and Agriculture to B-2 (Highway Business), Industrial and Agriculture zoning districts was presented for approval on first reading. **Mr. Scott moved; seconded by Mr. Taylor.**
