

MINUTES OF THE COUNCIL

May 9, 2019

6:30 P.M.

The Murray City Council met in regular session on Thursday, May 9, 2019, at 6:30 p.m. in the Council Chambers of City Hall with Mayor Bob Rogers presiding.

Mayor Rogers called the meeting to order and welcomed Council members and guests.

After a moment of reflection, Danny Hudspeth led the Pledge of Allegiance to the Flag.

The minutes of the Council meeting of April 25, 2019 were presented for approval. **Mr. Roberts moved for approval; seconded by Mr. Bolin. All members present voted Aye.**

Mayor's Report

Mayor Rogers recognized Dr. Strieter and Ms. Rouse, co-chairs of the Beautification Committee. Dr. Strieter and Ms. Rouse thanked the many volunteers who helped with planting the flowers downtown and painting the fence at the Park. A complete list of volunteers are attached to the minutes.

Public Hearing for the purpose of obtaining written or oral comments regarding the proposed use of Municipal Aid funds and Local Government Economic Assistance funds for FY 2020. **Dr. Miller moved to open the public hearing; seconded by Mr. Bell. All members present voted Aye.**

Mayor Rogers invited anyone present to address the Council or provide written comments. There were none. **Mr. Hudspeth moved to close the public hearing; seconded by Mr. Roberts. All members present voted Aye.**

Resolution 2019-006 a resolution adopting and approving the execution of a Municipal Aid Co-op Program contract with the Commonwealth of Kentucky for FY 2020.

Mayor Rogers called for a roll call vote.

Mayor Rogers recognized Personnel and Finance Committee Chair, Danny Hudspeth. Chair Hudspeth reported the Committee had a meeting prior to the Council meeting with two items on the agenda: public comment from Ms. Sue Hood, and the FY 19-20 draft budget. He stated the Committee unanimously voted to accept the original FY 19-20 draft budget, leaving the \$25,000.00 allocation for Murray Main Street, and to split the Park allocation of \$200,000.00 to \$175,000.00 for operations and \$25,000.00 for special projects.

Ordinance Number 2019-1776 (first reading) an ordinance adopting the City of Murray, Kentucky Annual Budget for the period of July 1, 2019 through June 30, 2020, for the General Fund; Cemetery Fund; Alcohol Beverage Control; Municipal Aid Tax Fund; E-911 Fund; Court Award Fund; Local Government Economic Assistance Fund; Murray Natural Gas System; Murray Water and Sewer System; Murray Storm Water System; Sanitation, Transfer Station, and Central Garage Division; by estimating revenues and appropriating funds for the operations of City government.

Ordinance Number 2019-1775 (second reading) an ordinance amending City of Murray Code of Ordinances Chapter 115: Solicitors and Peddlers, specifically to include a new subsection §115.06 to establish a pilot program of regulations for mobile food vehicles and pushcarts in the City and to amend §115.02: Using streets or public premises; Exception; and §115.05 prohibiting solicitation on streets and byways for the purpose of identifying the pilot program as an exception in these respective subsections. This Ordinance shall become effective on June 1, 2019. **Mr. Bolin moved for approval; seconded by Mr. Bell.**

Mayor Rogers called for a roll call.
