

MURRAY PLANNING COMMISSION MINUTES
REGULAR MEETING

The Murray Planning Commission met in regular session on Tuesday, March 15, 2022 at 4:30 p.m. in City Hall at 500 Main Street.

Chairman Krieb called the meeting to order and welcomed all guests. Kim Miles called the roll. Chairman Krieb asked for approval of the minutes from the regular Planning Commission meeting on December 21, 2021.

Cami Duffy made a motion to approve the minutes from the regular Planning Commission meeting on December 21, 2021 as presented. Martin Milkman seconded the motion and the motion carried unanimously.

Discussion: Comprehensive Plan Discussion: Dannetta Clayton came forward to present. Dannetta stated that we have now signed a contract with KLC and the next step is to get a core group together of people from the Planning Commission, BZA, Planning Staff, and Community Members. The Mayor will appoint those on the committee from the list of those interested. KLC will come here in July and all meetings and public forums will be held at City Hall. Land Use will be the first year, then Base Study, Transportation, Community Facilities and Goals, which has to go to City Council. The Board suggested having around eight people for the committee as that is what worked last time. The Board asked if one year was enough time to complete the Land Use portion and what the first step would be in the process. Dannetta responded that KLC thinks one year would be enough time and she is not sure what the first step will be but they mentioned doing a lot of outreach including surveys, online, mailings, public forums, etc.

David Roberts made a motion to adjourn. Cami Duffy seconded the motion. The motion carried unanimously. The meeting adjourned at 4:38 p.m.
