AN ORDINANCE AMENDING ORDINANCE NUMBER 2017-1738, AN ORDINANCE WHICH ADOPTED THE FY 2018 CITY OF MURRAY, KENTUCKY ANNUAL BUDGET BY RESTATING CERTAIN REVENUES AND EXPENDITURES FOR THE CITY OF MURRAY OPERATIONS BUDGET.

WHEREAS, the Personnel and Finance Committee met July 13, 2017, to discuss the utilization of the proceeds from the sale of assets received in fiscal year 2017; and

WHEREAS, the Personnel and Finance Committee reviewed the funds utilization plan presented by management; and

WHEREAS, the Personnel and Finance Committee discussed the need to replace the leaf removal equipment used by the City employees; and

WHEREAS, the Personnel and Finance Committee discussed the need to update and standardize two of the City's dump truck equipment; and

WHEREAS, the Personnel and Finance Committee discussed the need to acquire a second brine sprayer for utilization in snow removal services; and

WHEREAS, the Personnel and Finance Committee discussed the need to replace the broken, large format copier used by the Planning Department; and

WHEREAS, the Personnel and Finance Committee discussed the need to designate funds for the acquisition of a Mobile Air Filling Station for use in the Fire Department and a vehicle with capacity to haul the Mobile Air Filling Station; and

WHEREAS, the Personnel and Finance Committee discussed transferring the remaining proceeds to the operating funds of the City's Sanitation System in order to match the allocation of remaining funds back to the system of origin for ongoing business; and

WHEREAS, the Personnel and Finance Committee discussed City staffing and the reinstatement of funding for a full time City Administrator; and

WHEREAS, the Personnel and Finance Committee intends to effectively budget and plan for anticipated needs of the City,
