

ORDINANCE NUMBER 2018-1766

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING ORDINANCE NUMBER 2018-1753, AN ORDINANCE WHICH ADOPTED THE FY 19 CITY OF MURRAY, KENTUCKY ANNUAL BUDGET BY RESTATING CERTAIN REVENUES AND EXPENDITURES FOR THE CITY OF MURRAY OPERATIONS BUDGET.

WHEREAS, the Finance and Personnel Committee met on November 20, 2018, and discussed a 2018 COPS Office STOP School Violence: School Violence Prevention Program (SVPP) Grant received by the City of Murray Police Department in the amount of \$74,216 in federal funds; and

WHEREAS, the local cash match required for this award will be \$24,739; and

WHEREAS, the grant funds are to be used to improve security at schools and on school grounds within City of Murray jurisdiction through evidence-based school safety programs; and

WHEREAS, the Committee recommends amending the budget to accept the grant funds accordingly; and

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT HEREBY ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL FOR THE CITY OF MURRAY, KENTUCKY AS FOLLOWS:
