EXCUSED IN-PERSON ABSENTEE VOTING

May 4th-May 11th, 2022 between 8am and 4:30pm in the Office of the Calloway County Clerk, 101 South 5th St. Murray

NO VOTING ON SATURDAY or SUNDAY

ELIGIBILITY: PER KRS 117.085, eligible voters must meet one of the requirements

- Student who resides temporarily outside of his/her county
- Voter or Voter's spouse who has surgery/hospitalization scheduled during Early Voting & Election Day
- Voter who is a resident of KY covered by KRS 117A.010, military member confined to a military base
- In last trimester of pregnancy
- Voter who temporarily resides outside the state but is still eligible to vote in KY
- Age, disability or illness will be unable to attend early voting or Election Day vote centers
- Voter whose employment requires work all days and hours the polls are open during no excuse early voting and Election Day
- Election Officers scheduled to work this election cycle

Kentucky Observes Closed Primary Elections

In the 2022 Primary Election, Democrats and Republicans are eligible to vote in the Primary Election.

We do not have any non-partisan races on this Primary Ballot.

The Deadline to change your party affiliation was Dec. 31, 2021 to vote in this party's PRIMARY ELECTION. If you changed your affiliation after that date, you are NOT ELIGIBLE to vote in this Primary Election.

Voter Process for Mail-In Absentee

- Make application on the State Board of Election online portal or call 270 753 3923
- Your ballot will be sent via US Mail

- FOLLOW THE INSTRUCTION SHEET
- SIGN ALL INDICATED SIGNATURE LINES
- MARK BALLOT
- RETURN IN THE PROVIDED ENVELOPE

YOU MAY RETURN BY MAIL OR AT THE DROP BOXES LOCATED OUTSIDE ON THE SOUTH SIDE OF THE COURTHOUSE MAPLE STREET OR THE DROP BOX LOCATED INSIDE THE CALLOWAY COUNTY CLERK'S OFFICE 2ND FLOOR 101 SOUTH 5TH ST.

Voter Process for all In-Person Voting.

Have your ID ready, Driver's licenses are the most efficient method to scan. Election Officers verify your identity and you will be issued a paper ballot. VOTERS will review and mark the ballot and then CAST YOUR VOTE!
