

Code Enforcement Board Minutes July 12, 2016

The Murray Code Enforcement Board met in regular session on July 12, 2016 at 5:00 p.m. in the Council Chambers of City Hall located at 104 North 5th Street.

Board Members Present: Acting Chairman Mitzi Key, Mike Basiak, and Kim Griffith.

Others Present: Officer Tim Fortner, Attorney Chip Adams, Nathan Young, Kathy Britt, Steve Tapp, Officer Kyle Waldron, Major Chris Scott, Maressa Travis and general audience.

The meeting was called to order by Acting Chairman Mitzi Key. Roll call attendance was taken.

Approval of April 26, 2016 minutes: Kim Griffith made a motion to approve the minutes of the April 26, 2016 meeting and Mike Basiak seconded. A voice vote was taken and the motion passed.

Public Hearing—Nathan Young: Chairman Key called the public hearing to order and Maressa Travis read the case information. Chairman asked if any of the board members had any direct or indirect financial or personal interest in the matter. All board members answered no. Chairman called the city representative forward. Chairman called Kathy Britt forward and she was sworn in. Mrs. Britt stated she was sidetracked by personal issues involving her husband's health and failed to transfer stickers from one vehicle to another. Member Griffith requested clarification in regards the purchase of the sticker for her vehicle. **Member Griffith made a motion to dismiss the judgement and Member Basiak seconded. A voice vote was taken and the motion carried 3-0.**

Chairman called Officer Kyle Waldron back to the stand and he stated he did write the violation for this vehicle. Chairman asked if any of the board members had any direct or indirect financial or personal interest in the matter. 
A business meeting was discussed in regards to citation dismissals. It was determined that citations issued but currently compliant can be brought before the board for dismissal.
