The Murray City Council met in regular session on Thursday, October 12, 2023, at 6:30 p.m. in the Council Chambers at City Hall with Mayor Bob Rogers presiding.

Mayor Bob Rogers called the meeting to order and welcomed Council members, staff, and guests.

Ordinance 2023-1855 (Second reading) an ordinance amending city of Murray Code of Ordinances, Chapter 75: Occupational License Tax to include a new subsection, specifically 75.18: Rebate or Retention in accordance with the Kentucky Business Investment Incentive Program in order to consider allowing rebates or retention of the Occupational License Tax, up to one percent (1%) for a business entity approved for a Tax Incentive Agreement with the Kentucky Economic Development Finance Authority.

and continued eligibility under the Kentucky Business Investment Incentive Program in conjunction with the Kentucky Economic Development Finance Authority.
