

**MINUTES OF
COUNCIL**

January 10, 2019

The Murray City Council met in regular session on Thursday, January 10, 2019, at 6:30 p.m. in the Council Chambers of City Hall with Mayor Bob Rogers presiding.

Mayor Rogers called the meeting to order and welcomed Council members and guests.

After a moment of reflection, Danny Hudspeth led the Pledge of Allegiance to the Flag.

The minutes of the Council Meeting of December 13, 2018, were presented for approval. **Mr. Roberts moved for approval; seconded by Ms. Rouse. All members present voted Aye.**

Mayor's Report

He stated this is where any citizen who has any concern about anything going on in the community can sit down with the volunteer to identify the issue, and get an answer. Mayor Rogers stated we want to be open and receptive to the needs of the community. He stated the telephone number to the community liaison's office is 761-CITY.
