

**MINUTES OF
COUNCIL**
October 25, 2018
6:30 P.M.

The Murray City Council met in regular session on Thursday, October 25, 2018, at 6:30 p.m. in the Council Chambers of City Hall with Mayor Jack Rose presiding.

Mayor Rose called the meeting to order and welcomed Council members and guests.

After a moment of silence, Danny Hudspeth led the Pledge of Allegiance to the Flag.

The minutes of the Council Meeting of October 11, 2018 were presented for approval. **Mr. Roberts moved for approval; seconded by Mr. Bell. All members present voted Aye.**

Mayor's Report

Mayor Rose recognized Ron Allbritten. Mr. Allbritten shared the following: a list of sidewalks which have been retrofitted to meet ADA accessibility requirements, a list of resurfaced streets, and the remaining streets to be resurfaced this year. He stated in 2018, a total of 8.8 miles of City streets will be resurfaced, which is unprecedented.

Mayor Rose recognized Tom Kutcher. Mr. Kutcher gave an update on the progress of three capital projects: the Wastewater Treatment Plant upgrade, the Water Plant Clearwell project, and the East Clarks River Pump Station project.

Public Comment Mayor Rose reported there were no requests for public comment.

Ordinance Number 2018-1762 (second reading) an ordinance amending Ordinance Number 2018-1753, an ordinance which adopted the FY 2019 City of Murray, Kentucky annual budget by restating certain revenues and expenditures for the City of Murray operations. **Mr. Bohannon moved for approval; seconded by Mr. Roberts.**

Mayor Rose called for a roll call vote.

Mayor Rose recognized Jeremy Buchanan. Mr. Buchanan stated the Planning Commission recommended Ordinances be drafted to accept the dedication and maintenance of streets into the City. He stated the streets have been built according to City requirements.

Recommendation by the Planning Commission accepting the dedication and maintenance by the City of Murray the streets identified as Opportunity Drive, Wagon Wheel Drive, Carriage House Drive, and Cross Cut

Drive – Applicant: Vintage Hills Phase I. **Mr. Pittman moved for approval; seconded by Ms. Shoemaker. All members present voted Aye.**

Recommendation by the Planning Commission accepting the dedication and maintenance by the City of Murray the street identified as Kingdom Court – Applicant: City West Commercial Development. **Mr. Roberts moved for approval; seconded by Mr. Pittman. All members present voted Aye.**

With no other business before the Council, **Mr. Billington moved to adjourn; seconded by Mr. Bohannon. All members present voted Aye.**

The meeting adjourned at 6:58 p.m.
