

**MINUTES OF
COUNCIL**
November 20, 2018
6:30 P.M.

The Murray City Council met in regular session on Tuesday, November 20, 2018, at 6:30 p.m. in the Council Chambers of City Hall with Mayor Jack Rose presiding.

Mayor Rose called the meeting to order and welcomed Council members and guests.

After a moment of silence, John Mark Roberts led the Pledge of Allegiance to the Flag.

The minutes of the Council Meeting of November 8, 2018, were presented for approval. **Dr. Miller moved for approval; seconded by Mr. Bohannon. All members present voted Aye.**

Mayor's Report

Mayor Rose stated if you want a copy of the report from the Hospital City/County Night or more information to let him know.

Mayor Rose stated at noon on January 1, 2019, City and County officials will gather at the intersection of 5th and Main Streets. He stated Judge Jameson will be in attendance to swear in the officials that are able to attend.

Public Comment Mayor Rose recognized Kristen Farley. Ms. Farley presented a proposal for a greener Murray. She stated the two changes she would like to see is the frequency of Make A Difference Day and to have a restriction or ordinance on single-use plastic products, specifically the plastic straw. Ms. Farley stated Murray deserves the Friendliest Town in America to be the greenest as well.

Mayor Rose recognized Personnel and Finance Committee Chair, Johnny Bohannon. Chair Bohannon reported the Committee had a meeting prior to the Council meeting with two items on the agenda. Chair Bohannon recognized Kim Wyatt to explain Ordinance Number 2018-1766. Ms. Wyatt stated the Ordinance is for the 2018 Stop School Violence Program Grant to install cameras in the Murray Independent Schools. She stated there is \$74,216.00 in federal funds, and a local match of \$24,739.00, for a total of \$98,955.00.

Ordinance Number 2018-1766 (first reading) an ordinance amending Ordinance Number 2018-1753, an ordinance which adopted the FY 19 City of Murray, Kentucky annual budget by restating certain revenues and expenditures for the City of Murray Operations Budget. **Mr. Pittman moved for approval; seconded by Mr. Billington.**

Mayor Rose called for a roll call vote.

Chair Bohannon recognized Cathy Morris to explain Ordinance Number 2018-1767. Ms. Morris stated the Ordinance is a pay progression plan for the remaining employees who were not impacted by the Police and Fire pay progression plans. She stated the plan is very similar to the Police and Fire plans. Ms. Morris stated there will be a 75% credit for equivalent work experience, and a 25% credit for relevant work experience. She stated the amounts are only estimates, and she will meet with each employee to review their experience, certifications, and to confirm experience with previous employers.

Ordinance Number 2018-1767 (first reading) an ordinance amending Ordinance Number 2018-1753, an ordinance which adopted the FY 19 City of Murray, Kentucky annual budget by restating certain revenues and expenditures for the City of Murray Operations Budget. **Mr. Billington moved for approval; seconded by Ms. Shoemaker.**

Ordinance Number 2018-1763 (second reading) an ordinance accepting four (4) newly constructed streets located in Vintage Hills Phase I Subdivision, specifically: a street being 30 feet in width and approximately 2,648 feet in length, having a dedicated right-of-way of 60 feet, known as Opportunity Drive; a street being 29 feet in width and approximately 180 feet in length, having a dedicated right-of-way of 50 feet, known as Wagon Wheel Drive; a street being 29 feet in width and approximately 161 feet in length, having a dedicated right-of-way of 50 feet, known as Carriage House Drive; and a street being 29 feet in width and approximately 179 feet in length, having a dedicated right-of-way of 50 feet, known as Cross Cut Drive. **Mr. Roberts moved for approval; seconded by Mr. Bell.**

Mayor Rose called for a roll call vote.

Ordinance Number 2018-1764 (second reading) an ordinance accepting a new street, being 30 feet in width and approximately 311 feet in length, having a dedicated right-of-way of 50 feet, known as Kingdom Court. **Mr. Bell moved for approval; seconded by Mr. Roberts.**

Mayor Rose recognized Jeremy Buchanan to discuss the two revisions to the Sign Ordinance made after the first reading for clarification. Mr. Buchanan stated the revisions do not change the intent of the Ordinance.

Ordinance Number 2018-1765 (second reading) an ordinance amending the City of Murray Zoning Ordinance to amend Chapter 156.050 Signs in order to update text and clarify current sign regulations for the City of Murray. **Mr. Pittman moved for approval; seconded by Mr. Roberts.**
