

**MINUTES OF
COUNCIL**
November 8, 2018
6:30 P.M.

The Murray City Council met in regular session on Thursday, November 8, 2018, at 6:30 p.m. in the Council Chambers of City Hall with Mayor Jack Rose presiding.

Mayor Rose called the meeting to order and welcomed the newly elected Council members, the newly elected Mayor, and guests.

After a moment of silence, Jane Shoemaker led the Pledge of Allegiance to the Flag.

The minutes of the Council Meeting of October 25, 2018, were presented for approval. **Mr. Roberts moved for approval; seconded by Ms. Shoemaker. All members present voted Aye.**

Mayor's Report

Mayor Rose stated per City ordinance, the next meeting will be November 20, 2018, and there will be one meeting in December, which is December 13, 2018.

Public Comment Mayor Rose reported there were no requests for public comment.

Mayor Rose recognized Long Range Planning Chair, Jason Pittman. Chair Pittman reported the Committee had a meeting prior to the Council meeting with one item on the agenda: Ordinance Number 2018-1765, an update to the Sign Ordinance. Chair Pittman stated the committee voted unanimously to move forward with the Ordinance. Chair Pittman stated the Ordinance has fewer regulations upon businesses, and addresses legal issues from the Supreme Court ruling of Reed v. Gilbert. He stated the Committee did add a \$50 fee for changeable copy signs. The Council had a brief discussion.

Ordinance Number 2018-1765 (first reading) an ordinance amending the City of Murray Zoning Ordinance to amend Chapter 156.050 Signs, in order to update text and clarify current sign regulations for the City of Murray. **Mr. Pittman moved for approval; seconded by Ms. Shoemaker.**

Mayor Rose called for a roll call vote.

Mayor Rose recognized Transportation Committee Chair, Dan Miller. Chair Miller reported the Committee had a meeting prior to the Council meeting with one item on the agenda: Intersection Alignment for 8th and Chestnut Streets. **During the Committee meeting, Mr. Roberts made a motion to continue with the alignment of the intersection. Chair Miller stated the motion failed due to a lack of a second.** He stated the item might be brought back before the Committee at a later time.

Ordinance Number 2018-1763 (first reading) an ordinance accepting four (4) newly constructed streets located in Vintage Hills Phase I Subdivision, specifically: a street being 30 feet in width and approximately 2,648 feet in length, having a dedicated right-of-way of 60 feet, known as Opportunity Drive; a street being 29 feet in width and approximately 180 feet in length, having a dedicated right-of-way of 50 feet, known as Wagon Wheel Drive; a street being 29 feet in width and approximately 161 feet in length, having a dedicated right-of-way of 50 feet, known as Carriage House Drive; and a street being 29 feet in width and approximately 179 feet in length, having a dedicated right-of-way of 50 feet, known as Cross Cut Drive.

Mr. Bell moved for approval; seconded by Mr. Roberts.

Mayor Rose called for a roll call vote.

Ordinance Number 2018-1764 (first reading) an ordinance accepting a new street, being 30 feet in width and approximately 311 feet in length, having a dedicated right-of-way of 50 feet, known as Kingdom Court.

Mr. Roberts moved for approval; seconded by Mr. Bohannon.

Mayor Rose called for a roll call vote.
