

MINUTES OF THE COUNCIL

October 10, 2019

6:30 P.M.

The Murray City Council met in regular session on Thursday, October 10, 2019 at 6:30 p.m. in the Council Chambers of City Hall with Mayor Bob Rogers presiding.

Mayor Rogers called the meeting to order and welcomed Council members and guests.

After a moment of reflection, Linda Cherry led the Pledge of Allegiance to the Flag.

The minutes of the Council meeting of September 26, 2019 were presented for approval. **Mr. Roberts moved for approval; seconded by Ms. Seiber. All members present voted Aye.**

Mayor Rogers recognized Transportation Committee Chair, Jeremy Bell. Chair Bell reported the Transportation Committee had a meeting prior to the Council meeting with one item on the agenda: parking spaces on 14th St. and Olive Blvd. He stated the Committee unanimously voted for the City to retake possession of the parking spaces on 14th St. where Woods Hall was located, to provide an additional four or five parking spaces on Olive Blvd., and to limit the parking to one hour. **Mr. Bell moved for approval; seconded by Dr. Miller. All members present voted Aye.**

Mayor Rogers recognized Long Range Planning Committee Chair, Pat Seiber. Chair Seiber reported the Long Range Planning Committee had a meeting prior to the Council meeting. She stated the Committee unanimously voted to accept the recommendation of the Planning Commission to update the Zoning Ordinance.

Ordinance Number 2019-1789 (first reading) an ordinance amending Chapter 156: The City of Murray Zoning Ordinance, specifically §156.004 Definitions; §156.014 General Regulations for Vehicles; §156.035 Residential Districts (R-1 & R-2), §156.036 Multi-Family Districts (R-3, R-3A, R-4, R-5); §156.037 Business Districts; §156.038 Professional Office District; §156.039 Industrial District; §156.042 Agricultural District and creating a new subsection, specifically §156.045 Use Classification Table.

Ordinance Number 2019-1787 (second reading) an ordinance amending Chapter 54: Storm Water Utility, specifically Chapter §54.02, Paragraphs (D) and (E) for the purpose of updating the stormwater utility fee to adequately accommodate the costs of funding water quality mandates, drainage improvement projects and system rehabilitations. **Dr. Miller moved for approval; seconded by Mr. McCuiston.**

After a brief discussion, Mayor Rogers called for a roll call vote.

Ordinance Number 2019-1788 (second reading) an ordinance creating a new chapter 134, Municipal Appeals Board, in order to adopt and ensure compliance with ordinances of the City of Murray, specifically establishing an appeals board where no appeals board currently exists for those appeals set forth in ordinances that provide for an appeal upon a final decision by the administrative action of the administrator, department or other city agency. **Mr. Roberts moved for approval; seconded by Dr. Young.**

Mayor Rogers called for a roll call vote.

Municipal Order Number 2019-050 reappointing Bobby Martin to the Senior Citizens Board for a one (1) year term. Said term expires November 20, 2020. **Mr. Hudspeth moved approval; seconded by Ms. Rouse. All members present voted Aye.**

Municipal Order Number 2019-051 reappointing Bobbie Weatherly to the Board of Zoning Adjustments for a four (4) year term. Said term expires October 27, 2023. **Ms. Cherry moved approval; seconded by Ms. Rouse. All members present voted Aye.**

Recommendation to set Halloween hours. **Dr. Miller made a motion to set Trick or Treat hours inside the City limits on October 31, 2019, from 5:00 p.m. to 7:30 p.m.; seconded by Mr. McCuiston. All members present voted Aye.**

With no other business before the Council, **Mr. Bell moved to adjourn; seconded by Ms. Elder. All members present voted Aye.**
