

## MINUTES OF THE COUNCIL

November 25, 2019

12:00 P.M.

The Murray City Council met in a special-called session on Monday, November 25, 2019 at 12:00 p.m. in the Council Chambers of City Hall with Mayor Pro Tem Danny Hudspeth presiding.

Mayor Pro Tem Hudspeth called the meeting to order and welcomed Council members and guests.

After a moment of reflection, John Mark Roberts led the Pledge of Allegiance to the Flag.

**For Ratification or Rejection of the Real Estate Purchase Agreement for 623 North 4<sup>th</sup> Street, Murray KY.** Mayor Pro Tem Hudspeth recognized Jim Osborne. Mr. Osborne stated 623 North 4<sup>th</sup> Street is adjacent to the City cemetery property, and has been on the market for \$295,000.00. He stated the City has reached an agreement to purchase the property, with Council approval, for \$200,000.00. Mr. Osborne stated there is one home and one guest house on the property, along with outbuildings. He stated it's between 5.5 and 5.6 acres that the City can use for cemetery plots in the future. **Mr. Bell moved for approval; seconded by Mr. Roberts.** Dr. Young asked if Tract 1 will be inaccessible to North 4<sup>th</sup> Street because of a ditch. Mr. Osborne stated it will allow a 66 foot frontage access area to North 4<sup>th</sup> Street for the future, if desired to do so. **All members present voted Aye.**

**If ratified, for approval and authorization for the Mayor or his designated agent, to execute all required closing documents, including, but not limited to, deed, closing disclosure, and to pay all buyer cost associated with this purchase.** Mr. Bell moved for approval; seconded by Ms. Rouse. **All members present voted Aye.**

With no other business before the Council, **Mr. Bell moved to adjourn; seconded by Dr. Strieter. All members present voted Aye.**

The meeting adjourned at 12:05 p.m.
